

Allergic reaction

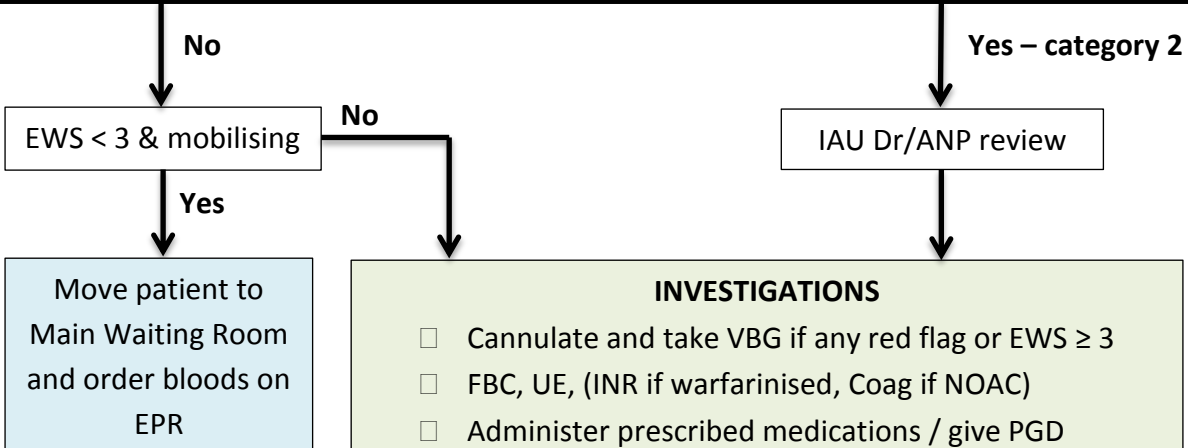
Fully undress, perform observations, apply gown and wristband
Check Allergies and Anticoagulant Medications

ASSESSMENT

- Perform full A-E assessment

*****Red Flags*****

- EWS ≥ 4
- Airway compromise (stridor, enlarged tongue, altered speech, unable to swallow)
- Received adrenaline pre hospital
- Short of breath or O_2 sats $< 95\%$



Move patient to Main Waiting Room and order bloods on EPR

PLAN

- Apply nursing orders e.g. Venepuncture (see below)
- Explain process to patient/relative
- Complete accountability handover
