

Diabetes problem

Fully undress, perform observations, apply gown and wristband
Check Allergies and Anticoagulant Medications

ASSESSMENT

- Perform full A-E assessment (including BM)
- Take capillary ketones and VBG and get results reviewed by Dr/ANP

*****Red Flags*****

- EWS ≥ 4
- Drop in GCS of 2 or more from baseline
- Abnormal VBG e.g Consider DKA protocol
- Sepsis – follow IAT

IAU Dr/ANP review

Move to waiting room and order bloods and ECG on EPR

INVESTIGATIONS

- Cannulate
- FBC, UE (INR if warfarinised, Coag if NOAC)
- ECG and get it reviewed by Dr/ANP
- Administer prescribed medications / give PGD

PLAN

- Apply nursing orders e.g urinalysis
- Explain process to patient/relative
- Complete accountability handover
