### CHILD UNDER AGE 16 WITH HYPOGLYCAEMIA (BM < 2.6)

# NEONATE (<1 Mth) Treat all SEE NEONATAL FLOW CHART Refer to Paeds

NON DIABETIC BM <2.6 **KNOWN DIABETIC**BM < 4.0

SEE HYPOGLYCAEMIA IN DIABETES FLOW CHART Refer to Paeds

#### **ASSESS SYMPTOMS**

Behavior: Hunger, Mood change, Restless/Irritable, Combative, Confused, Lethargy, Coma

Skin: Pale, Sweaty, Clammy

**Neuro:** Headache, Weakness, Visual/Speech disturbance, Tremor, Fits

## NO SYMPTOMS

### **INVESTIGATE FIRST**

Aim to take samples before commencing treatment if child asymptomatic – call for paeds support for bloods if needed

Use ED Paeds Orderset on EPR: Use Paeds Hypo Box in resus for blood bottles

(Paeds Blood bottles: 1x Red, 3x Orange, 1x Yellow, 2xWhite, Guthrie Card, Urine: Urine pad – White container)

\*\*ammonia must be in lab within 15 min\*\*

### **SYMPTOMATIC**

### **TREAT NOW**

Do not delay treatment if severe symptoms

IV Access: 2ml/kg 10% dextrose, then IV maintenance with 10% dextrose/ 0.9% NaCl

1 hrly BM - Aim BG 4-6 mmol/L

No IV access: 1/2 tube of Glucogel onto buccal mucosa – recheck BM @ 20 min. If still <2.6 give IM / SC Glucagon

- Neonate 20mcg/kg
- Child < 25kg 0.5mg</li>
- Child > 25kg 1mg

Then IV fluids
