## ED Senior – Roles and Responsibilities

- 1. Work with the nurse in charge to maximise flow and department efficiency. Complete 2 hourly touch points with the nurse in charge when they are completing the department sitrep to review and develop plans for patients in the department.
- 2. Ensure timely clinical assessment of patients (Cat 1/2 seen <1hr, ECG's reviewed within 10min).
- 3. Supporting the team to make timely and effective management plans (aim for all patients to have a plan by 3hr).
- 4. Lead the handover meetings where all majors/resus patients are reviewed and any issues in department are discussed and resolutions found at 08:00, 13:00, 17:00, 22:00.
- 5. Ensure senior review in line with RCEM guidelines (returns within 72 hours, adult chest pain, abdominal pain over 60 years, under 1 year olds with a fever)
- 6. If the consultant is leaving the department with Dr wait >2hr complete the narrative section of the sitrep on EMBeds to describe the plan to manage the risk in the department.
- 7. Have oversight of all patients needing admission, to understand the reason they need admitting to hospital.
