CONI is a programme that provides support for families who have experienced or at higher risk of **sudden infant death** (SIDS) or sudden and unexpected baby death, and who are expecting/have given birth to a new baby.

CONI support includes:

- Movement (breathing) monitor
- Daily symptom diary
- Baby Check App

 symptom assessment tool
- Sheffield weight chart –to assess weight gain in babies
- Alarm record

Parents may be alerted to request help due to changes in their baby identified by the above.

The **family health visitor** offers extra visits and is the key worker with the family.

In many areas the baby is offered open access to a senior **paediatrician**, to the children's ward or clinic as per local arrangements.
