Always act in the best interest of the child. If decision thought to be unsafe for child/young person, would need to consider safeguarding children action.</p>
- Younger baby or child attending with adult/parent/carer who wish to DAMA. Always act in the best interest of the child - legally a person is still a child until their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday. If decision thought to be unsafe for child/young person, staff would need to consider safeguarding children action.
