





What is Covid Oximetry@Home

This service provides patients with excellent care from qualified clinical colleagues and a free to use pulse oximeter machine so that you can be supported in your own

Why use the service?

Covid positive patients sometimes don't realise how poorly they are, as they can develop low oxygen levels and not become breathless. This is why it is important to monitor your oxygen levels using the oximeter. Using this machine helps you get the support you need, as soon as you need it, giving you a greater chance of getting better and surviving Covid-19. It also means you can be supported in your own home.

What happens when you use the Covid Oximetry@home service?

Covid positive patients will be sent an easy to use pulse oximeter machine which measures their blood oxygen levels. This is the most accurate way of tracking their health whilst they have Covid-19. By taking and recording regular readings, you can keep an eye on your progress and contact one of our clinicians if your blood oxygen levels starts to drop, especially if you have no other symptoms. If you are at a higher risk of becoming poorly, we will contact you regularly to make sure you're doing ok.
